Swiss Travel System tickets and passes.



Swiss Travel System tickets and passes are the key to Switzerland's extensive public transport network. They guarantee practically unlimited travel by train, bus and boat.

Swiss Travel Pass Coverage: unlimited travel by train, bus and boat, including premium panoramic trains, plus public transportation in more than 90 towns and cities. Young travellers up to their 26th birthday receive a 15% discount off the standard price of a Swiss Travel Pass.
Validity: 3, 4, 8 or 15 consecutive days. **Bonus:** 50% discount on most mountain railways, free admission to more than 500 museums.

Swiss Travel Pass Flex Coverage: unlimited travel by train, bus and boat, including premium panoramic trains, plus public transportation in more than 90 towns and cities. Young travellers up to their 26th birthday receive a 15% discount off the standard price of a Swiss Travel Pass Flex. **Validity:** 3, 4, 8 or 15 freely selectable days within one month. **Bonus on travel days:** 50% discount on most mountain railways, free admission to more than 500 museums.

Swiss Half Fare Card Coverage: up to 50% discount on travel by train, bus and boat as well as on most mountain railways and public transportation in more than 90 towns and cities. **Validity:** 1 month.

Swiss Family Card Coverage: free family card complementary to standard Swiss Travel System tickets. Children from their 6th up to their 16th birthday travel free of charge when accompanied by at least one parent with a valid Swiss Travel System ticket.

Eurail Global Pass and Interrail Global Pass

The Eurail Global Pass is ideal for persons with permanent residence outside Europe. The corresponding product for guests from Europe (permanent residence in a European country) is the Interrail Global Pass.

Coverage in Switzerland: The Global Pass offers free travel on most railway lines, 50% discount on some lake excursions, and 25% discount on some mountain excursions. It is available in 1st and 2nd class.

Coverage in Europe: Unlimited travel in 32 European countries.

Interrail One Country Pass

The Interrail One Country Pass, available for persons with permanent residence in Europe, is a flexible offer for 3, 4, 5, 6 or 8 days of validity within one month in one of many European countries, including Switzerland.

Tickets for travelling to Switzerland.

Depending on which country guests arrive from, different tickets are possible. **Standard** and **supersaver** tickets are available in all countries. Supersaver seats are usually limited, whereas standard fare tickets have unlimited availability and offer a free choice of trains.

Across Switzerland by train, bus and boat? Easy! With these tips, nothing stands in the way of a comfortable journey.

Regular-interval timetable and connections

Trains always leave at the same minute after each full hour. Main inter-city connections operate at half-hour intervals. PostBus and boat connections are also coordinated with these regular-interval timetables. Thus, changing transportation modes is easy and trouble-free throughout Switzerland. The complete timetable is available at [sbb.ch](https://www.sbb.ch) or via the SBB smartphone app. Additional information is available on-site at railway station counters.

1st class

On a journey, an upgrade from time to time is a very nice thing. 1st class coaches provide that dash of extra comfort: wider seats, more legroom, and power outlets. Also, passengers benefit from separate quiet and business zones.

Luggage services

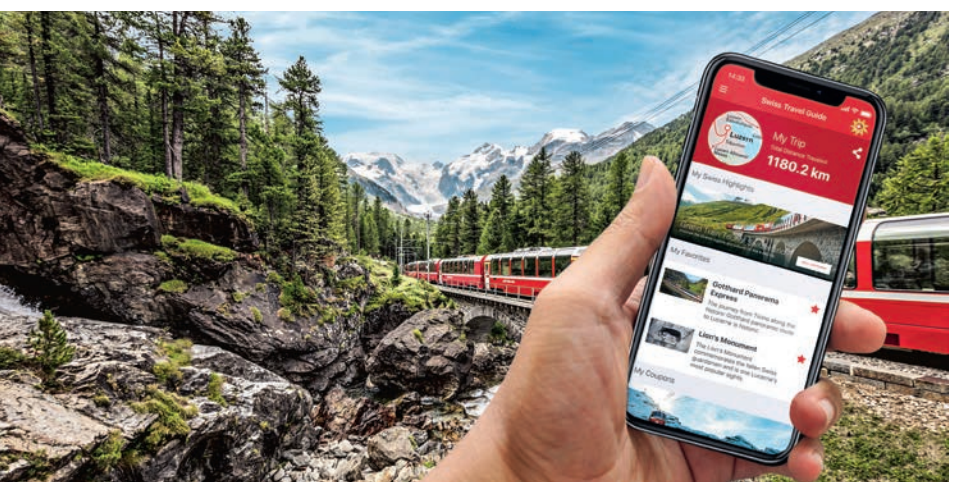

On track with hydropower

Climate-friendly travelling.

By public transport, you will enjoy carefree travel across Switzerland – and it is even climate-friendly. The following means of transportation operate in an environmentally friendly way, turning your journey into a special experience.

Solar power ahoy!

Even in Switzerland, which is blessed with water, solar power plays an important role. With the solar-powered “MobiCat” on Lake Biel, the country has the world's largest solar catamaran. It has already ferried more than 40,000 people – all with the power of the sun. High in the mountains, the Swiss also rely on the same power source: The world's first battery-powered cableway leads up to the Alpstein mountain massif in Eastern Switzerland using only solar energy. From the summit, a stunningly beautiful view as far as Lake Constance opens up.



MS Diamant – climate-neutral on Lake Lucerne

Famous excursion mountains and fjord-like landscapes as far as the eye can see – that's travelling on the MS Diamant. The modern motor vessel is a landmark achievement in Swiss navigation with regards to quality and innovation. It also sets new standards as Switzerland's first climate-neutral regular-service boat. To this end, the SGV AG (Lake Lucerne Cruises) has entered into a partnership with the non-profit foundation myclimate. So, a twin benefit on the way.

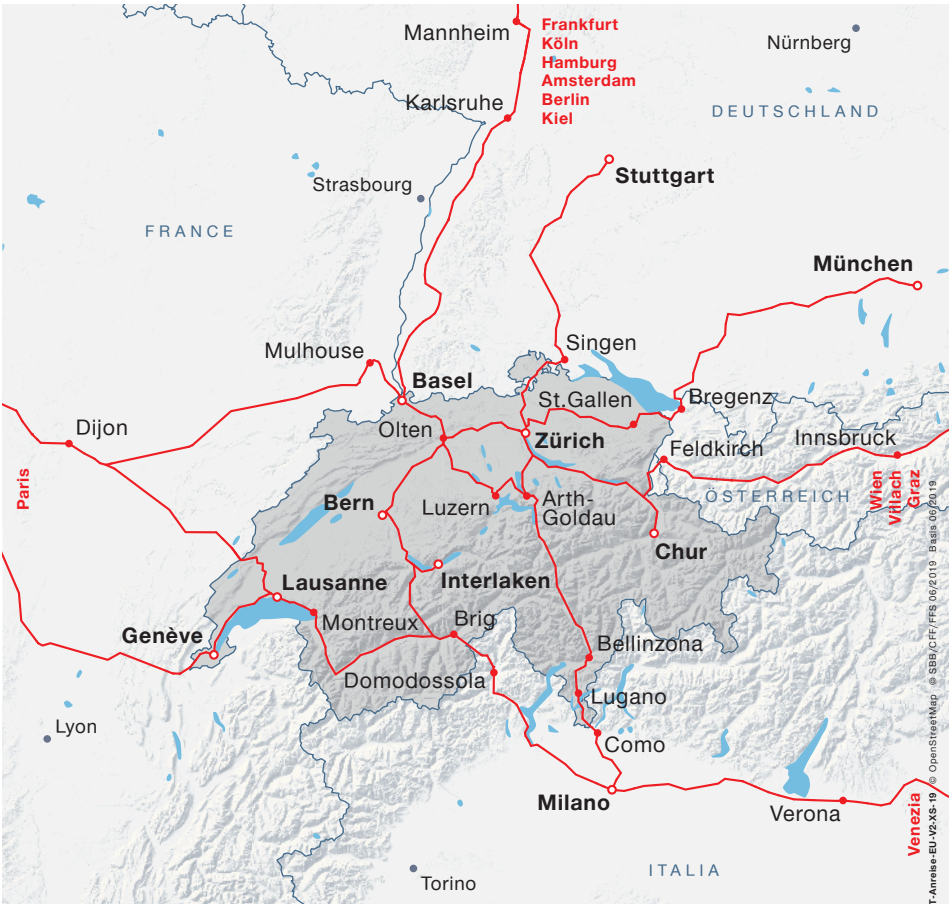
Arrival.

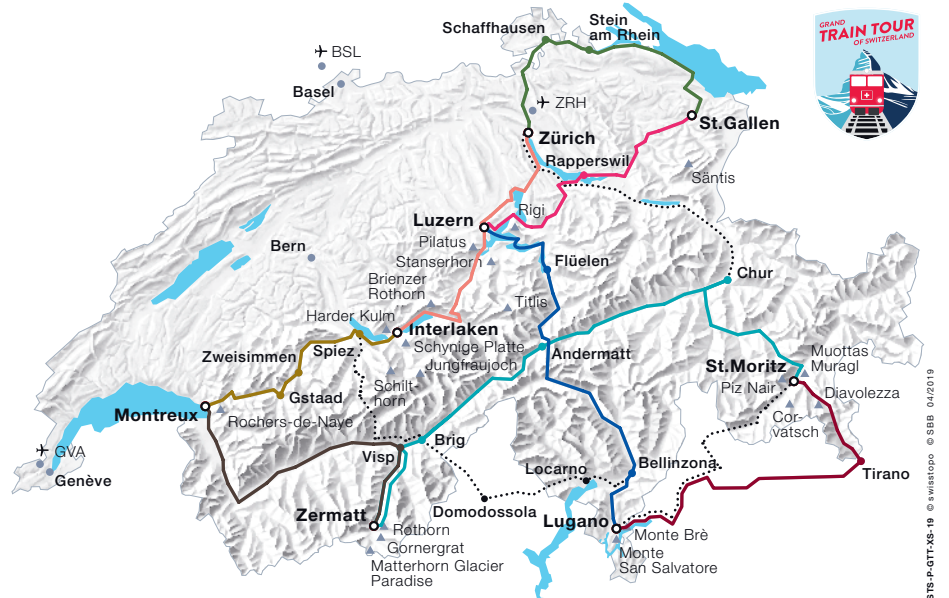

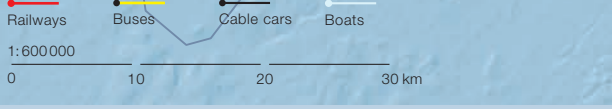

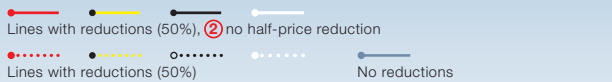

Premium panoramic trains



A seat reservation and/or supplement is required to travel on some trains/buses/boats such as the Glacier Express, Bernina Express, Gotthard Panorama Express, Palm Express, etc.

The premium panoramic trains.

Swiss premium panoramic trains are world-famous. They delight visitors with modern conveniences, large panoramic windows and unobstructed views of the scenic splendours of the Alpine nation.

Bernina Express: from Chur to Tirano or Lugano
From north to south, from glaciers to palm trees: Tackling gradients of up to 70% on the way, the train crosses the Solis Viaduct and climbs to the Ospizio Bernina at 2,253 metres. In summer, the journey can be extended aboard the Bernina Express Bus from Tirano along Lake Como to Lugano.

Glacier Express: from Zermatt to St. Moritz
The Glacier Express takes passengers on a journey for the senses: from the Matterhorn to the Engadine. With its ceiling-high panoramic windows, this exceptional train experience offers an unobstructed view onto unique landscapes along the way.

GoldenPass Panoramic: from Zweisimmen to Montreux
During the journey on the GoldenPass Panoramic, the tradition-rich Bernese Oberland merges with the Mediterranean flair of French-speaking Switzerland. The ride in the VIP seats right at the front of the train is particularly impressive.

Gotthard Panorama Express: from Lugano to Lucerne
Tracing Switzerland's history – by land and by water: The journey combines the panoramic train with a boat cruise and is accompanied by interesting staged presentations about the history and myths surrounding the Gotthard. From Ticino via the historic Gotthard route and Lake Lucerne, the journey eventually takes visitors to lovely Lucerne.

Lucern–Interlaken Express: from Lucerne to Interlaken
Step on the train in Central Switzerland, lean back, and arrive in the Jungfrau region just under two hours later. The ride on the Lucern–Interlaken Express leads past turquoise lakes and numerous waterfalls.

Scenic mountain adventures.

A quintet of highlights – in every way. Authentic. Sustainable. Impressive. And experienced at a discount by Swiss Travel Pass holders.

Gornergrat, 3,089 m a.s.l.
Amid no fewer than 29 4,000-metre peaks, the Gornergrat offers a spectacular 360° panoramic view from the Matterhorn to the Dufourspitze. From Zermatt station, Europe's highest-altitude open-air cog railway takes passengers towards this stunning summit.

Jungfraujoch, 3,454 m a.s.l.
Top of Europe – high Alpine fascination of eternal ice and snow. It is a destination of unending magical power. Clear days allow the eye to rove almost endlessly from the Vosges to the Black Forest. The train arrives at the Jungfraujoch via tunnels through the glaciers of Eiger and Mönch.

Rigi, 1,797 m a.s.l.
The "Queen of the Mountains" – easily accessible by train, bus and boat: A total of nine mountain railways lead up the enormous rock massive, and 120 kilometres of hiking trails open up a wealth of possibilities. Majestic sunrises and sunsets included. And best of all: The visit to Rigi is fully included in the Swiss Travel Pass.

Schilthorn, 2,970 m a.s.l.
Piz Gloria – panoramic view in all its glory and the world's first revolving mountain restaurant: The Schilthorn summit highlights the beauty of high Alpine scenery to perfection and presents the UNESCO World Heritage Site with Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau in a most spectacular way.

Titlis, 3,020 m a.s.l.
It is the only accessible glacier in Central Switzerland and it also has the highest suspension bridge in Europe – not to mention an impressive glacier relief. Even the ride up to the summit in the Titlis Rotair, the world's first revolving cableway, is an adventure.
