General information for all travel suggestions.

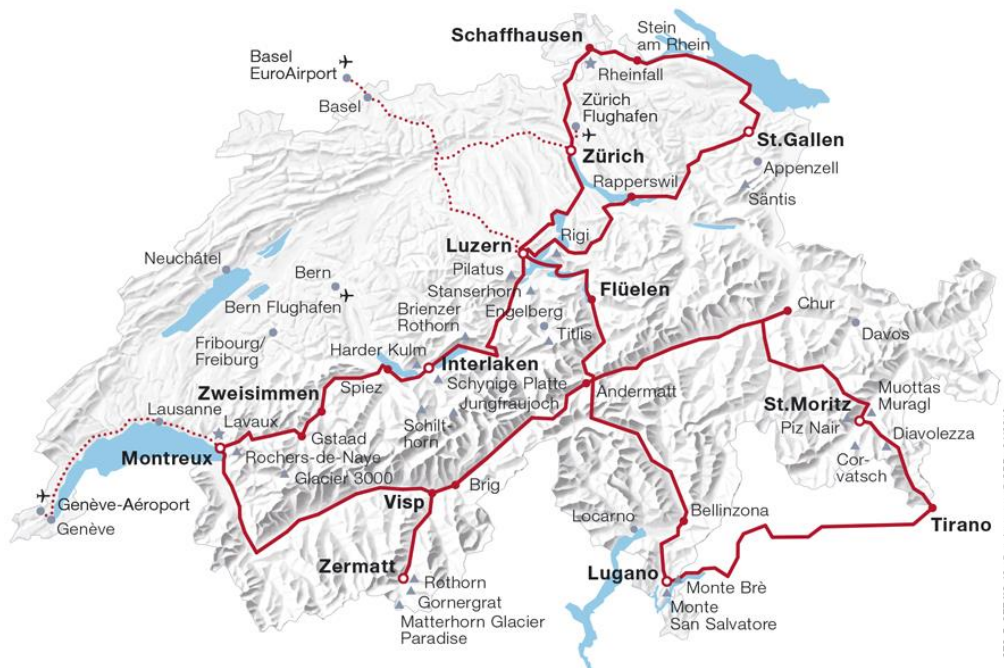
- Starting point and endpoint, places of overnight stays, and travel direction are freely selectable

On the “Original” route, guests experience the entire Grand Train Tour of Switzerland and travel on all panoramic trains to the highlights and sights of Switzerland.

1. Zürich/Genève*/Basel – Luzern – Interlaken (Luzern–Interlaken Express), from 2 h 51 min
2. Interlaken – Zweisimmen – Montreux (GoldenPass MOB), 3 h 5 min
3. Montreux – Visp – Zermatt, 2 h 31 min
4. Zermatt – St. Moritz (Glacier Express), 7 h 46 min
5. St. Moritz – Tirano – Lugano (Bernina Express), 6 h 46 min
6. Lugano – Flüelen – Luzern (Gotthard Panorama Express), 5 h 30 min
7. Luzern – St. Gallen (Voralpen-Express), 2 h 17 min
8. St. Gallen – (Stein am Rhein** –) Schaffhausen – Zürich/Genève*/Basel, from 2 h 34 min

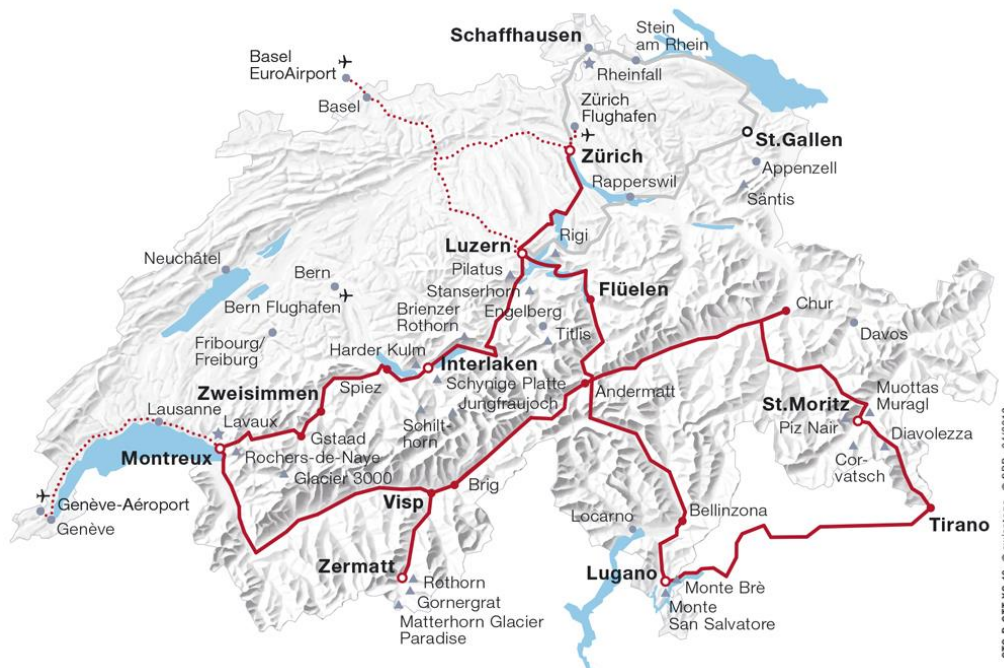

“Classic” route.

Whether the view of the Matterhorn from Zermatt, the ride on the Glacier Express, or the stroll across the Chapel Bridge in Lucerne – on this journey, each classic follows hot on the heels of the next.

Stages:

1. Zürich/Genève*/Basel – Luzern – Interlaken (Luzern–Interlaken Express), from 2 h 51 min
2. Interlaken – Zweisimmen – Montreux (GoldenPass MOB Panoramic), 3 h 5 min
3. Montreux – Visp – Zermatt, 2 h 31 min
4. Zermatt – St. Moritz (Glacier Express), 7 h 46 min
5. St. Moritz – Tirano – Lugano (Bernina Express), 6 h 46 min
6. Lugano – Flüelen – Luzern (Gotthard Panorama Express), 5 h 30 min
7. Luzern – Zürich/Genève*/Basel, from 45 min

A route packed with Swiss highlights – that’s the “Top Attractions” tour. It takes travellers to Interlaken, Lucerne, Montreux and Zermatt. World-famous mountains as well as numerous top sights and landmarks wait to be explored here.

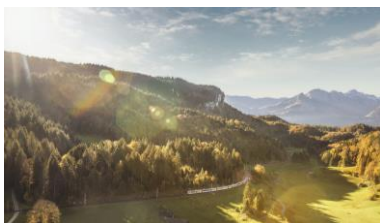


Duration: 5 days / 4 nights, or more

Stages:

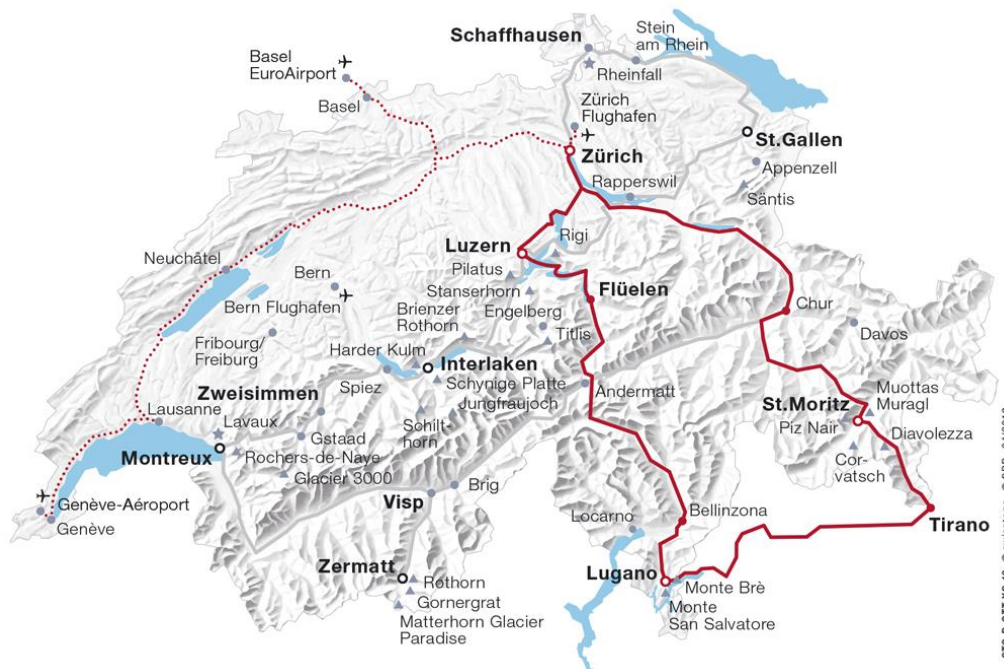
1. Zürich/Genève*/Basel – Luzern, from 45 min
2. Luzern – Interlaken (Luzern–Interlaken Express), 1 h 49 min
3. Interlaken – Zweisimmen – Montreux (GoldenPass MOB Panoramic), 3 h 5 min
4. Montreux – Visp – Zermatt. 2 h 31 min
5. Zermatt – Chur (part of Glacier Express) – Zürich/Genève*/Basel, from 7 h 31 min

* When arriving from Geneva, it is recommended to start and end the tour at Montreux.



“Glaciers & Palm Trees” route.

The name says it all: Guests pass imposing glaciers as well as sun-kissed palm trees on this tour. Here, the sweet “dolce vita” combines perfectly with the Swiss mountain world.



Duration: 4 days / 3 nights, or more

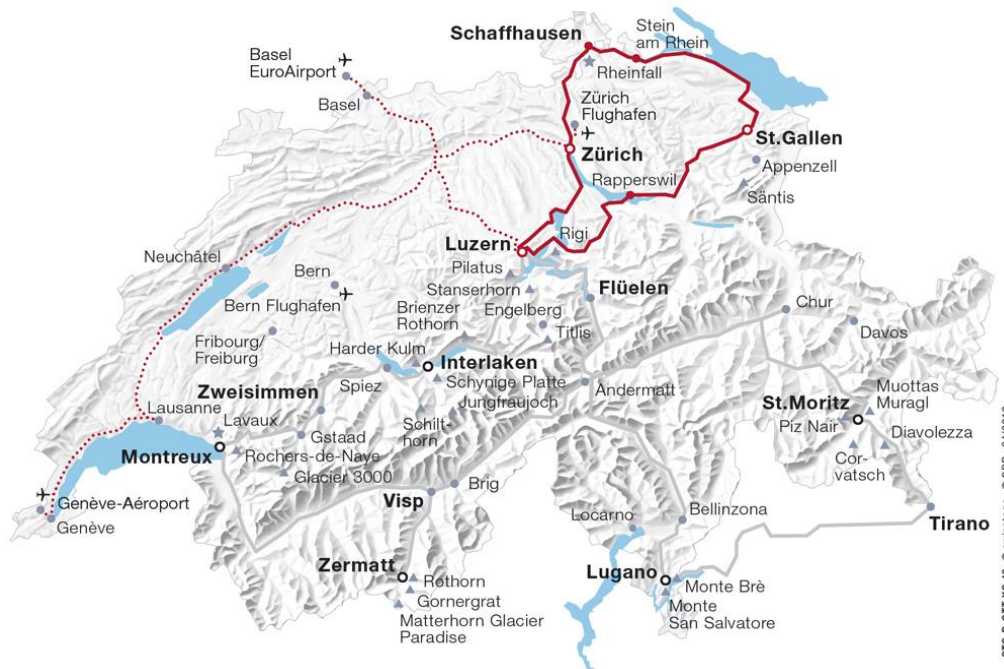
Stages:

1. Zürich/Genève/Basel – Chur – St. Moritz, from 3 h 21 min
2. St. Moritz – Tirano – Lugano (Bernina Express), 6 h 46 min
3. Lugano – Flüelen – Luzern (Gotthard Panorama Express), 5 h 30 min
4. Luzern – Zürich/Genève/Basel, from 45 min



“Stunning Waters” route.

On this tour, travellers discover all shapes and types of the precious element of water. Every body of water can be marvelled at from the train – from Lake Zurich via the Rhine Falls and right through to Lake Bodensee.

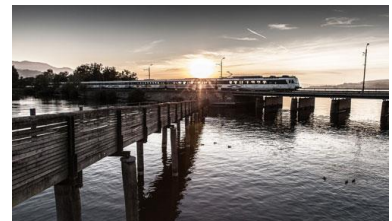


Duration: 3 days / 2 nights, or more

Stages:

1. Zürich/Genève/Basel – Luzern, from 45 min
2. Luzern – St. Gallen (Voralpen-Express), 2 h 17 min
3. St. Gallen – (Stein am Rhein* –) Schaffhausen – Zürich/Genève/Basel, from 2 h 34 min

** optional: river cruise between Stein am Rhein and Schaffhausen



“Hidden Treasures” route.

This tour leads across pastoral hillsides, through the “100 valleys” (Centovalli), and to historic cities.



Duration: 3 days / 2 nights, or more

Stages:

1. Zürich/Genève/Basel – Luzern – Interlaken (Luzern–Interlaken Express), from 2 h 51 min
2. Interlaken – Spiez – Brig (Lötschberger) – Domodossola – Locarno (Centovalli), 4 h 50 min
3. Locarno – Bellinzona – Luzern (Gotthard Panorama Express) – Zürich/Genève/Basel, from 6 h 44
